

## Introducing the Full-time Program

The Higher Marks Educational Centre (HMEC) is a registered private school with the Grenada Ministry of Education and provides a stimulating, full-curriculum education for students between **Kindergarten and Grade 6**.

(Minimum age is 5 yrs. by December 31, 2017)

The program was designed specifically for children who need a more hands-on and practical approach to learning and mixes traditional instruction with independent homeschool-type learning. It is a Christian-based program.

## The Curriculum

In addition to regular subjects commonly taught in schools, our program offers subjects that allow children to discover and display their unique talents and to provide them with an opportunity to enhance their self-confidence, public speaking and thinking skills. ## Classes & Exams

Monday to Friday from 8:15 to 3:15 P.M.

Children must bring their own snacks and lunch. Healthy snacks and lunches are encouraged.

Class size: 15 children maximum.

**EXAMS:** MCT (Minimum Competency) Exams are written each year for grades 2, 4 and 5. Regular testing and end-of-term exams are conducted each term. Some exams are done as orals. Some courses, such as Leadership and Etiquette include a practical component.

The school's Director of Studies, Mrs. Novia John, M.A. (Ed. Psych.), has been an educator for over 28 years. Her desire is to see children maximize their potential through tailored instruction that meets their academic needs; opportunities for self-expression in the classroom; learning that includes practical, hands-on activities; development of their creative abilities and opportunities to demonstrate leadership.

The co-director, Ms. Stasia Blake, B.A. (Psych.), has been an educator for over 18 years. She is particularly interested in producing disciplined, organized children who will grow to be responsible citizens.

These two directors bring a combination of skills that are critical to the success of any student. Teachers are chosen carefully and are guided by the Directors in their approach and delivery of content.

## Registration

To register, please call the school at 435-9235 to set up an appointment. During your appointment, your child will be given a preliminary assessment in mathematics, reading and general language arts. This test will inform us of your child's academic level.

A program application form (available from the office) must be completed and submitted, along with a copy of the child's immunization record and birth certificate.

## Fees

**Program registration fee:** \$500. 00

(\$100 waived for HMEC students already enrolled in the tutoring program).

**School Fees:**

**Pre-Kindergarten & Kindergarten = \$760/term**

**Grades 1 - 6 = \$760 /term.**

Payments must be submitted within the first week of each term.
